



**** Drug Reporting in HIPAA 5010 ****

In 5010, professional claims for injectable medications must include additional drug information and qualifiers, such as National Drug Code (NDC), quantity, and composite unit of measure.

Currently providers must submit a HCPCS code as the service-line procedure along with the total charge and units of service.

In 5010, you will now be required to also submit the NDC Drug Quantity and Composite unit of measure. Providers who submit service-line drug charges must ensure that the drug quantity and unit of measure can be submitted.

Print Image, and Link1500 submitters: This information can be added to your claims using field 19 on the CMS-1500 form. You can locate information about using field 19 and correct formatting of information by viewing the "Field 19" document under the Support Documents page on the MD On-Line website. Note that if your quantity of information needed to adjudicate your claim exceeds the limit of characters allowed into field 19, simply type the word EXTRA into Field 19. When you transmit your claim an extra page will open with options to enter data for that claim.

Claims that do not include this information may be rejected.
