

MD On-Line President and CEO Bill Bartzak Inducted Into Entrepreneurial Hall of Fame

When addressing friends and colleagues at the Induction Dinner, Bartzak spoke about teamwork as a fundamental tenet of a successful enterprise. "At MD On-Line, we've been incredibly careful to hire the right people — those who want to work hard, be successful, and make a difference not only for themselves but also for the team," he said. "Without people challenging themselves every day, and without the team challenging itself as a whole every day, we wouldn't have experienced the incredible amount of growth that we have. Nobody works *for* me, everybody works *with* me — it's all about how successful we can be together."

Bartzak was inducted into the Hall of Fame along with fellow entrepreneur and Seton Hall alumni Charles Alberto, Founder and President of Form Cut Industries, Inc., a Newark-based producer of precision-formed parts for consumer products and automotive, aerospace, and medical supplies.
